SNAP PROGRAM

Last year over 100 cats and 25 dogs were spayed and neutered through our Spay and Neuter Program (SNAP). SNAP helps individuals and families in our communities with household incomes of \$30,000 or less, to access affordable spay and neuter services for up to two pets per household.

THE NEW CAT WING

In November 2018, LAWS demolished the old cat area of the shelter and started the construction of a new cat wing. This great facility opened its doors in September 2019. It consists of 7 large and 3 small cat rooms, a new staff lunch room and a storage/utility room. The cat rooms are cageless and very bright to make for a more pleasant and comfortable environment for the cats and our visitors.

Over the past 40 years, Lanark Animal Welfare Society (LAWS) has served the residents and communities of Lanark County and surroundings areas. Our mission has always remained simple:

To promote the welfare of animals committed to our care, to provide shelter and care, and to prevent cruelty and suffering for those animals in need through outreach and education.

As an independent no-kill shelter, LAWS does not euthanize for population control, age, breed or time in the shelter. Euthanasia is only used where animals so ill that quality of life is impacted. All animals are loved and cared for until a suitable home is found.

Each year forever homes are found for approximately 600 cats and 25 dogs.
